## History

Tricula MV was a British Motor Tanker of 6,221 tons built in 1936 by Howaldtswerke AG, Kiel and owned by Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co Ltd, London.

On the 3rd August 1942 she was torpedoed and sunk by German submarine U-108 when on route from Curacao for Trinidad and Capetwon with a cargo of 8,000 of crude oil.
