PETRIANA; Length: 79.4 m.; Owned by Asiatic Petroleum Co. Ltd.; Built at A. Leslie & Co. in 1879. Registered at London.

On 28 November 1903, *PETRIANA* (Capt. William Kerr) was on voyage from Balikpapan, Borneo to Melbourne with a cargo of 1300 tons oil, when she was lost after running aground.
