Leticia was a Dutch cargo steamer of 2,850 tons built in 1928. On the 27th June 1940 when on route from CURACAO for FALMOUTH carrying a cargo of 2589 tons gas oil she was attacked by U-47 with gunfire and sunk. 2 crew lost from a total crew 30.
