San Conrado MV was a British Motor Tanker of 7,982 tons built in 1936 by Blythswood Shipbuilding Company, Scotstoun, Yard No 42 for the Eagle Oil Company. She was powered by a diesel engine. Engines by J.G.Kincaid. On the 1st April 1941 she was bombed and sunk in an air attack off the Smalls, English coast.
