History

[Lettens Jan](#) 24/08/2012

On October 24th, 1944, U.S. submarine USS [Snook](#) (SS-279 Lt.Cdr. G.H. Browne) torpedoes and sinks the army cargo ships [Arisan Maru](#) and [Sinsei Maru No.1](#).

[Arisan Maru](#), takes 1777 souls, mainly American prisoners with her, causing the greatest maritime disaster ever for the US.

Army tanker [Kikusui Maru](#) sinks as well as the result of damage inflicted by [Snook](#) the day before.

[Kikusui Maru](#) was a Japanese Tanker of 3,887 tons. She was formerly the Dutch Tanker IRIS which was scuttled on the 15th February 1942 near Palembang to avoid capture by the Japanese. She was salvaged by the IJN, renamed [Kikusui Maru](#). She was sunk by torpedo from the American submarine USS [Snook](#) on the 24th October 1944, north west of Luzon.
