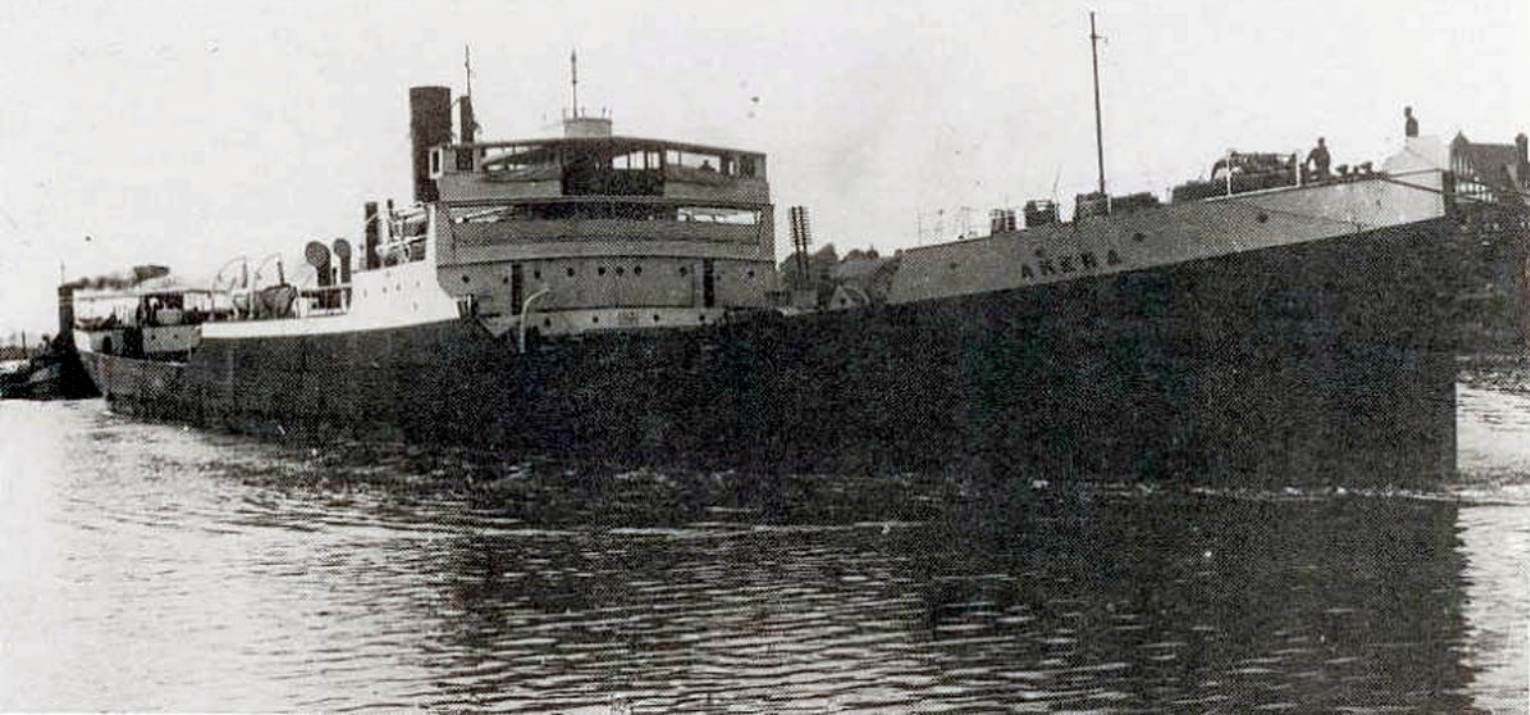


The Mediceo was built in Glasgow in 1918 as the War Singer for the Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Company. In 1921 the ship was renamed Akera. The ship was sold in 1927 to Prebensen & Blakstad, Risør, Norway. In 1939 the ship again changed hands. Sold to Ditta Marino Querci, of Genoa, Italy, she was converted to cargo ship and renamed Mediceo and placed under the Italian flag. When Italy surrendered to the Allies in September of 1943, Mediceo was seized by Germans and handed over to Mittelmeer Reederei GmbH. She was bombed by British aircraft January 31, 1945 and sunk off Tagliamento, Italy.
