


•Year of construction: 1940 •Discarded in:1942 •Tonnage: 9.265

She reached Malta successfully after beingbadly damaged by torpedoes of an Italian submarine. The ship broke in two after offload here cargo. In September 1946 the two halves of the Ohio were towed ten miles offshore and scuttled by gunfire.










