

- 27/4 1918** British steamer **ROMANY** ex Rossija ex Romany, torpedoed and sunk in the Mediterranean 47 miles S.W. by W.3/4 W. from Cape Spartivento, Sicily in position 38.22N 08.00E by the German submarine UB-48 whilst on a voyage from Marseilles to Port Said in ballast. (*Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. Ltd., London, 3.983 grt/1902*).
- 2/10 1918** British steamer **ARCH** torpedoed and sunk in the Atlantic 40 miles N.W. by W. from Tory Island in position 55.45N 07.35W by the German submarine U118 whilst on a voyage from Philadelphia to Portishead with a cargo of benzine. 52 lost including Master. (*Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. Ltd., London, 4.839 grt/1912*).
- 31/3 1916** British steamer **GOLDMOUTH** captured and torpedoed in the Atlantic 60 miles W.N.W. from Ushant by the German submarine U-44 whilst on a voyage from Tarakan to Falmouth with a cargo of fueloil. Master taken prisoner. (*Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. Ltd., London, 7.446 grt/1903*).
- 10/10 1916** British steamer **ELAX** torpedoed and sunk in the Mediterranean 70 miles W.S.W. from Cape Matapan in position 35.54N 21.19E by the German submarine UB-43 whilst on a voyage from Rangoon to Malta with a cargo of oil. (*Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. Ltd., London, 3.980 grt/1893*).
- 8/12 1916** British steamer **CONCH** torpedoed and sunk in the English Channel 12 miles S. by W. ½ W. from Anvil Point, 10 miles S. of Poole in position 50.23N 02.02W by the German submarine UB-23 whilst on a voyage from Calcutta and Rangoon to River Thames with a cargo of benzine. 28 lost including Master. (*Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. Ltd., London, 5.620 grt/1909*).
- 21/12 1916** British steamer **MUREX** torpedoed and sunk in the Mediterranean 94 miles N.W. from Port Said in position 32.20N 31.00E by the German submarine U-73 whilst on a voyage from Mudros, Aegean Sea to Port Said in ballast. 1 lost. (*Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. Ltd., London, 3.564 grt/1892*).
- 21/4 1917** British steamer **TELENA** torpedoed and sunk in the Atlantic 170 miles W.N.W. from the Fastnet Rock in position 51.16N 14.00W by the German submarine U-61 whilst on a voyage from Philadelphia to Queenstown with a cargo of benzine. (*Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. Ltd., London, 4.778 grt/1895*).
- 28/4 1917** British steamer **BULLMOUTH** torpedoed and sunk in the Atlantic 125 miles N.W. by N. from Tory Island in position 56.30N 11.20W by the German submarine U-58 whilst on a voyage from Clyde to Hampton Roads in ballast. (*Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. Ltd., London, 4.018 grt/1893*).
- 20/8 1917** British steamer **BULYSSES** torpedoed and sunk in the Atlantic 145 miles W.N.W. from the Butt of Lewis, Hebrides in position 58.34N 10.50W by the German submarine U-52 whilst on a voyage from the Firth of Forth to Port Arthur, Texas in ballast. (*Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. Ltd., London, 6.127 grt/1900*).

19/1 1918

British steamer **TROCAS** torpedoed and sunk in the Aegean Sea 10 miles N.E. from Skyro Lighthouse by the German submarine UC-23 whilst on a voyage from Abadan to Salonica with a cargo of oil. 24 lost. (*Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. Ltd., London, 4.129 grt/1893*).
