Allen Tony 28/04/2008

Donax MV was a British Motor Tanker of 8,036 tons built in 1938 by Harland & Wolff Ltd, Govan, Yard No 1008 for the Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Company. On the 22nd October 1942 when on route from AVOMMOUTH & BELFAST LOUGH for NEW YORK in ballast and in convoy 0N-139 she was torpedoed by German submarine U-443. REscure tugs HMS NIBLE & HMS MAURADER took her in tow but she sank. Crew of 63 sa ved.
