

History

Allen Tony 17/03/2008 Eulima MV was a British Motor Tanker of 6,207 tons built in 1937. On the 23rd February 1943 when on route from LIVERPOOL for NEW YORK in Convoy ON-166 and in ballast she was torpedoed by German submarine U-186 when about 310 miles S of Cape Race and sunk by torpedo and gunfire. Crew of 63 lost.
