History

Vleggeert Nico 11/12/2008

On route Maracaibo-Curaçao with crude oil, the Dutch tanker Rosalia was hit by 2 torpedoes from U-615 and sank in flames about 10 miles S of Curaçao. Twenty-three of her crew were killed, the 13 survivors were picked up by Dutch submarine chaser H-8 and rescueboat MBR-50. ref. used: www.arendnet.com
